## Children's Choir

### Daytime rehearsal on Wednesday

- please have your child at Southminster United Church by 11 am in the large gym
- we will line up/warm up in the large gym
- we will practice "Trolls" and
- "Season of Peace" with the symphony from 11:25 - 11:45
- we will practice "Carol of the Bells" with the symphony and all of the other choirs from 11:50 - 12:10

- your child will need to stay for the entire concert, as we will be singing "Carol of the Bells" at the end
